

# TUPLES

- an ordered sequence of elements, can mix element types
- cannot change element values, **immutable**
- represented with parentheses

*remember  
strings?*

`te = ()` *empty  
tuple*

`t = (2, "mit", 3)`

`t[0]` → evaluates to 2

`(2, "mit", 3) + (5, 6)` → evaluates to `(2, "mit", 3, 5, 6)`

`t[1:2]` → slice tuple, evaluates to `("mit", )`

`t[1:3]` → slice tuple, evaluates to `("mit", 3)`

`len(t)` → evaluates to 3

`t[1] = 4` → gives error, can't modify object

*extra comma  
means a tuple  
with one element*
